We've had the privilege recently of becoming better acquainted with listeners from remote areas. Many of these folks have listened for years and it's fun to find out what they appreciate most (and about the broadcast least!) content. Some of these listeners rarely get "to town" to take care of issues such as medical and dental appointments, supplies, business dealings, etc. We feel honored that they would take time out of their busy schedules to visit with their favorite (and sometimes only!) radio station.

We strive for teaching and preaching solid enough for someone to become born again and get discipled without ever changing the dial. Along with providing a mix of inspirational, encouraging, God-honoring music this can be quite a challenge! We find that listeners here, like most places, have favorite music styles, Bible teachers, and programs. Some outside of Alaska express surprise at the deep Biblical literacy of many remote listeners.

A listener recently wrote in, saying of the live Mukluk Message segments: "Many, many thanks for the program. It's a healing voice that seems to come along at

just the right times." Perhaps you or someone you know should pray about becoming one of the "healing voices in the wilderness" on our team. What a privilege to serve the Lord in this place!

- Kelsie Vrenna has capably filled the role of Station Manager at KAGV in Houston, AK, for several years. Her husband, Daniel, recently felt God leading him to ALSO enter the radio ministry in a full time capacity. We praise the Lord of the Harvest for answering our prayer for more willing workers in this ministry!
- KSCM in Scammon Bay has now completed all the paperwork and has received final approval from the FCC to broadcast the gospel to this
